Principal Duties & Responsibilities

- ✓ Perform on a regular basis analytical tests (HPLC, HPLC-SEC, GC-HS, FTIR, KF ...) on raw materials, finished and semi-finished products;
- ✓ Perform and manage various verification studies such as stability and *in vitro* degradation testing on Gecko's products;
- ✓ Perform and compile all analytical results and raw data in accordance with defined specifications and requirements;
- ✓ Use basic statistics to analyze results, trends and process capabilities;
- ✓ Assist the QC engineer on developing, implementing and validating new analytical methods required to control the quality of our products;
- ✓ Contribute to the general QC laboratory organization and quality, including equipment calibration and maintenance.
